#### Spare Clothes

Sometimes our children will have toileting accidents at school or get a bit wet when they are playing in the water. We would appreciate it if the children could keep a bag on their peg with spare pants, trousers and socks so that if they are wet we can change them. You can leave this bag at school if you wish to.

#### Outdoor Play

We will go out to play in most weather and it is important that the children are appropriately dressed. In the wet weather please feel free to bring wellies to school and we will put them on when we go outside. The children will always need a waterproof coat in school and a hat and gloves in the cold weather.

#### Snack Time

The children will be given a snack and drink at school every day. This is always a piece of fruit or a vegetable and water or milk. We ask that the children do not bring any other snacks or drinks to school so all children in Nursery have the same.

#### Muddy Mondays

Every Monday we will be going to explore our forest area. Muddy Mondays will happen in all weathers unless it is raining heavily or extremely cold. The children will need warm clothes on a Monday with wellies, a warm coat and gloves. It would be helpful if you could send a spare change of clothes with your children in case they get muddy.

## 14<sup>th</sup> January Keeping Healthy

During this week we will talk about how to stay healthy and the benefits of exercise. We will be going into the hall for some P.E sessions. At home you could do some exercise together; go for a walk or go to the park.



## 21<sup>st</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> January Winter

Over the two weeks we are reading the story 'The Snow Bear.' The little bear gets lost and needs help to find his mommy. At home talk to your child about the weather in winter, look for different signs of winter together and talk about what to do if they ever get lost while you are out.



## 4<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> February Jack and the Beanstalk

Over the two weeks we will be reading the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk', talking about the main characters and events. At home you could read a version of this story, have a go at doing some planting together or drawing a picture of the giant.



## 25<sup>th</sup> February and 4<sup>th</sup> March Healthy Eating

This week we will be looking at different types of fruits and vegetables. At home you could try to do some cooking together, look at different fruits and vegetables and talk to the children about their favourite ones. Maybe they could draw and write about it with you to bring in to show us.




## 11<sup>th</sup> March Transport

Over the two weeks we will be learning about different bugs and insects. At home you could go on a minibeast hunt in the garden or park. Look for worms, spiders, ladybirds, ants or caterpillars. Talk about how they are different and where they live.



## 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> April Nursery Rhymes

Over the two weeks we will be learning different Nursery rhymes linked to Easter. Hopefully, you will be able to come to our special assembly so we can perform some of nursery rhymes for you. We will send out a letter and a copy of the rhymes for you to help your child practise.
